Role of the Corporator

Corporators are voting members of the Greater Worcester Community Foundation. As a body, the membership is responsible for electing other Corporators and the Board of Directors. Corporators are elected to a term of five-years, commencing at the annual meeting. Members in good standing are eligible for re-election to one or more successive terms. Corporators may be invited to serve as active volunteers or committee members.

The Board of Directors is drawn from among the Corporators.

Responsibilities and expectations

Corporators are asked to show tangible support for the Greater Worcester Community Foundation in a variety of ways.

The purpose of the Foundation is to enhance the community through endowed philanthropy and nonprofit leadership, and Corporators are chosen because of their involvement in these types of community activities.

It is expected that each Corporator will personally do the following:

1. Attend the annual meeting and participate in the election of Directors and Corporators.
2. Learn about and support the Foundation's programs and services; and as often as possible, attend our events as a supporter of our mission and programs.
3. Make an annual financial contribution to the *Directors & Corporators Fund*, an operating reserve.
4. Consider the Foundation as part of your philanthropic planning.
5. Notify the Foundation President of any changes in contact information or a resignation.
